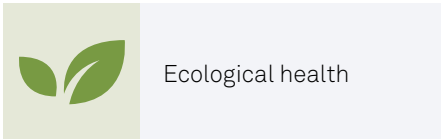
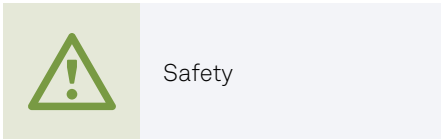
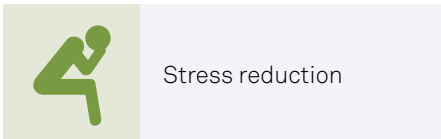




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Given the high stress of illness, healthcare facility designs have a meaningful impact on health outcomes. Fable Hospital is a fictional 300-bed facility based on the research findings on facilities evaluated by The Center for Health Design in order to present evidence in support of the business case for better buildings as a key component of better, safer, and less wasteful healthcare.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The study calculated \$11M in savings and increased revenue in the first year based on \$12M investment. Some hard numbers were calculated, for example \$2M in savings through preventing falls by patients. Another \$1M in savings was attributed to a reduction of drug costs based on patient comfort and positive distraction in the new environment.

HEALTH IMPACT

The new design features and hospital layout reduced patient falls by 80% and reduced Nosocomial infections by 4/month. Similarly, patient transfers between rooms was reduced by 80% which allowed for increased continuity of care and recuperation for the patients.

WHAT'S NEXT

Continued evaluation of health and financial impacts is continuing. The long-term impact take years to measure and participation of our consortium of progressive hospital partners
